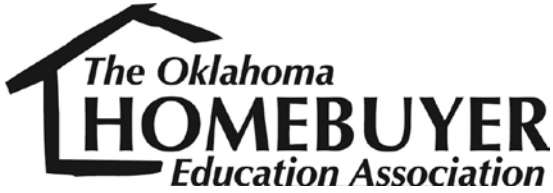

Fast-Track Certification Program

REINSTATING CHEP CERTIFICATION

Certified Homebuyer Education Professionals (CHEPs) who have allowed their certifications to expire may apply to reinstate their status. The reinstatement process involves studying updated curriculum provided by OHEA and passing the certification examination, which can be administered at the applicant's place of employment. Upon successful completion of the certification exam, candidates must complete the reinstatement process by attending a one-day course covering updates in industry practices and reviewing professional standards.

Applicants who do not demonstrate overall proficiency of 80% on the exam will be required to attend the five-day preparatory sessions before retaking the examination. (\$100 of the application fee will be credited to tuition for the five-day session.)

SUBMITTING AN APPLICATION FOR REINSTATEMENT

Complete this form and submit it with \$115 if your dues for the current year have been paid. Cost of reinstatement if your current-year dues are not paid is \$140. This fee covers the updated curriculum, test administration, the one-day training and final certification. Please make your check payable to OKACAA. Mail your application to
