OHEA Conference re-scheduled. The 12th Annual Homebuyer Education Conference will be held on Thursday, November 12, with Comprehensive Continuing Education sessions the following morning on Friday, November 13. We rescheduled the conference after a member pointed out that the original dates were over the Veterans Day holiday.

The Four C's of Credit (capacity, credit, capital and collateral) are all impacted by Dodd-Frank and policy changes that also have reduced the availability of down payment programs. Each one of the four c's is being evaluated with greater care that can result in repeated postponements of closing and even loss of financing late in the deal. Additional delays can occur when inspections or paperwork needed for special housing programs is overlooked. How do we prepare homebuyers for the higher level of scrutiny and protect them from the frustration or postponement or even loss of their deal?

We anticipate a highly participatory forum where the effects of qualified mortgages and the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau's combined TILA/RESPA document can be exchanged with the requirements for various popular housing programs available in Oklahoma. Our intent is to enable everyone involved to know, in advance, what has to be done for the deal to be completed. We are asking housing assistance agencies to bring program requirements including eligibility, inspections, and timelines. We are asking lenders, particularly underwriters, to outline the impact of qualified mortgages on investor requirements. So come learn what lenders now require and bring what you require. And if you don't have requirements, come to learn what is going on in today's affordable homeownership market. More details will be available next month.

The **OHEA Train the Trainer** session originally scheduled for the week of September 28 has been pushed back a week due to schedule conflicts. It will be held October 6 – 9 (that's Tuesday through Friday). We have a few people registered so we will hold the class. That gives you time to register or share information with a coworker or colleague. I've attached a registration form for your convenience. Please share it if you can't use it yourself.
